And be it enacted, That so much of article thirteen, of the public local law of Howard county, as in contained in the seventy-seventh section thereof, relating to primary schools, be and the same is hereby repealed, and the following section relating to primary schools in said county be substituted therefor: That the public school inspectors of said county, shall be entitled to receive such compensation as is now allowed by law to the county commissioners of Howard county to be levied annually by the county commissioners as other
