SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 25.

AN ACT to authorise and require the Treasurer of the State of Maryland, to pay to David C. Blackiston, administrator of William H. Blackiston, late of Kent county, deceased, a sum of money being an overpayment into the Treasury by said administrator. Passed Feb. 27, 1860.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Treasurer of the State of Maryland pay to David C. Blackiston of Kent county, administrator of William H. Blackiston, late of said county, deceased, the sum of one hundred and thirteen dollars and fifty-five cents, and interest thereon from the twenty-eighth day of January, in the year eighteen hundred and fifty-seven, it being an overpayment to the Treasurer, on the account of said William H. Blackiston, as collector of the State tax in Kent county, for the years eighteen hundred and forty-four and eighteen hundred and forty-five, and that the Comptroller be and that he is hereby authorised and required to issue his warrant for the same; and that this act shall take effect from its passage.
