CHAPTER 26.

Passed Feb.
27, 1860.

AN ACT to amend the fourth and fifth sections relating to the Almshouse of Queen Anne's county, of article seventeen of the Public Local Laws.

4th section.

SECTION. 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the fourth section of article seventeen of the Code of Public Local Laws relating to the almshouse of Queen Anne's county, be and the same is hereby repealed, and the following enacted as a substitute therefor: As often as any one of the said trustees shall die, resign, remove out of the county or become incapable from acting, the county commissioners of the county shall elect one of the citizens of said county in his place.

5th section.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That the fifth section of the said article, be and the same is hereby repealed, and the following enacted as a substitute therefor: Any free white male citizen of the county over twenty-one years of age, shall be qualified to act as trustee for the almshouse.

SEC. 3. *And it be enacted,* That this act shall take effect from and after its passage.
