No grand jury sitting at the time of any election shall be discharged until they have made written presentment on oath that they have diligently and to the best of their ability examined such judge of election as may have come before them, and inquired into and acted upon all complaints concerning alleged violations of the constitution and laws touching elections, at the election next preceding, &c.,	“	21
Grand jury, upon adjournment, shall present to court all judges who failed to come before them, who shall be at once arrested and held to answer at the next term ; State's attorney immediately to apply for and court to issue bench warrants for such arrest, &c. ; court to give this act in charge to each grand
