CHAPTER 32.

AN ACT to authorise the State Treasurer upon the warrant of the Comptroller, to pay over to Martha A. Lee, administratrix of Judge Z. Collins Lee, the salary of said Judge for the quarter ending the first day of January, eighteen hundred and sixty. Passed Feb. 24, 1860.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the State Treasurer upon the warrant of the Comptroller, pay over to Martha A. Lee, administratrix of the late Judge Z. Collins Lee, who departed this life November twenty-sixth, eighteen hundred and fifty nine, the quarter salary which would have been due on the first day of January, eighteen hundred and sixty. Authorised to pay.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.
