- The Clifton Manufacturing company of St. Mary's county, incorporated, 241

- A company incorporated to build a turnpike road from Libertytown in Frederick county, to interseet the Woodsboro' and Frederick turnpike road, at or near the Monocacy bridge, 252
- The Sonora and Arizona company, incorporated, 254
- The Merrill Patent Fire Arm Manufacturing company, incorporated, 256
- The act incorporating companies to make several turnpike roads through Baltimore county, amended, so as to authorise the Baltimore and Yorktown turnpike road company to lay a track of passenger iron railway on their said road between Baltimore city and Towsontown, and prescribing regulations therefor, 259
