- 292. An act to amend an act, passed January session, 1854, entitled, an act to incorporate the Towsontown Plank Road Company.
- 293. An act to authorize the Baltimore and Ohio Rail Road Company to subscribe to the capital stock of the Baltimore and Potomac Rail Road Company.
- 294. An act to add the following sections, relating to schools, to article 16 of the Code of Public Local Laws.
- 295. An act to make valid a deed from Nicholas E. Iglehart to John Owen, all of Howard county, State of Maryland.
- 296. An act to amend the 24th, 25th and 34th sections, relating to the city of Cumberland, of the 1st article of the Code of Public Local Laws.
