authorized to pay to William L. W. Seabrook eighteen hundred and eight dollars and nineteen cents, to Thomas J. Wilson nineteen hundred and seventy-one dollars and fifty cents, to John Cox nineteen hundred and twenty-three dollars and twenty-eight cents, to J. Wesley White eight hundred and seventy-five dollars and twenty-two cents, to Thomss Gody ninety-six dollars and fifty cents, to Collins, Heath and Hutchingson sixty-four dollars and seventy-four cents, to Henry P. Horton forty-eight dollars and seventy-five cents, to John H. Watson twelve dollars and fifty cents, and to James S. Waters ten dollars.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That this act shall Inforce. take effect from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 49.

AN ACT, to appropriate a sum of money to J. Passed Jan. Hopkins Tarr, late State's Attorney for Caroline 23, 1860. county, for certain fees due him by the State.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer, upon the warrant to pay. of the Comptroller, be and he is hereby authorised and directed to pay to the order of J. Hopkins Tarr, the sum of one hundred dollars and fiftyeight cents, being the amount of certain fees due him by the State.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, that this Act shall Inforce. take effect from the date of its passage.
