SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from and after its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 49.

AN ACT, to appropriate a sum of money to J. Hopkins Tarr, late State's Attorney for Caroline county, for certain fees due him by the State. Passed Jan. 23, 1860.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Treasurer, upon the warrant of the Comptroller, be and he is hereby authorised and directed to pay to the order of J. Hopkins Tarr, the sum of one hundred dollars and fifty-eight cents, being the amount of certain fees due him by the State. Authorised to pay.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, that this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.
