CHAPTER 57.

AN ACT authorising the Treasurer of the State of ^{Passed Feb.}
Maryland, upon the warrant of the Comptroller, ^{11, 1860.}
to pay to Captain John T. Sinn, a sum of money
therein mentioned, for services rendered by the
United Guards, by order of the Governor.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly* ^{Authorised}
of Maryland, That the Treasurer of the State pay ^{to pay.}
on the warrant of the Comptroller, to Captain Jno.
T. Sinn or order, the sum of two hundred dollars
for six days services rendered from October twenty-sixth, eighteen hundred and fifty-nine, to November second, eighteen hundred and fifty-nine, by the United Guards under his command, at Harper's Ferry Bridge by order of the Governor, to be by him distributed among the members of the aforesaid company according to the time they served.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall In force
take effect from its passage.
