the removal of any prisoners from the jail for Allegany County unless upon the order of the Circuit Court, or upon the expiration of a prisoner's term, or his release in full for a hearing either by the Circuit Court for Allegany County or a Justice of the Peace. Said Sheriff shall at the end of each month make a list of the prisoners in his custody and the reasons for their commitment, and post the same in the office of the county jail so that it may be read by those who desire to do so. Any false swearing in the report of the Sheriff or affidavit thereof to the Board of County Commissioners shall be deemed prejury and be punished as such. The said Sheriff shall also include in his monthly report a full statement of all fines and costs by him collected, and shall pay the same over to the County Treasurer. Any violations of the requirements of this Act or failure to comply therewith shall constitute a misdemeanor and be punished upon conviction by forfeiture of office. and fine or imprisonment or by all three, in the discretion of the Court.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1945.

CHAPTER 807.

(Senate Bill 599)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments, Section 626 of Article 1 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Allegany County," subtitle "State's Attorney," as said Section was amended by Chapter 197 of the Acts of 1941, increasing the salary of the County Investigator of Allegany County.

SECTION 1. Beitenacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 626 of Article 1 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Allegany County," sub-title "State's Attorney," as said Section was amended by Chapter 197 of the Acts of 1941, be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

626. It shall be the duty of the State's Attorney for Allegany County to maintain a Bureau of Identification,
