

WHEREAS, Section 24 of Article 52 is almost identical with Section 52 of Article 17, thereby making Section 52 of Article 17 unnecessary; therefore

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That section 52 of Article 17 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Clerks of Courts", sub-title "General Duties of Clerks", be and it is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1945.

CHAPTER 18.

(Senate Bill 15)

AN ACT to repeal Section 9 of Article 18 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Commissioners to Take Acknowledgments", said section imposing a tax on commissions issued to the Commissioners to Take Acknowledgments.

WHEREAS, the general law relating to tax on commissions has been repealed, so that this section is no longer applicable; therefore

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 9 of Article 18 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Commissioners to Take Acknowledgments", be and it is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1945.

CHAPTER 19.

(Senate Bill 18)

AN ACT to repeal Section 1 of Article 7 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Arbitration and Award", said section relating to arbitration between employees and corporations in which the State is a stockholder or creditor.
