salaries of the Collector of Taxes of Carroll County and his assistant.

SECTION 1. Beit enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 313A of Article 7 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Carroll County," sub-title "Revenue and Taxes," as said section was amended by Chapter 289 of the Acts of 1939, be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Carroll County is hereby authorized to appoint an assistant. Said collector and assistant shall receive in equal monthly installments annual salaries of not exceeding Twenty-four hundred dollars (\$2,400) and Fifteen hundred dollars (\$1,500), respectively, and said collector and assistant shall be entitled to no fees, commissions or compensation other than said salaries. The County Commissioners of said county shall annually levy and collect from the assessable property in Carroll County a sum of money sufficient to pay said salaries.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1945.

CHAPTER 955.

(Senate Bill 121)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 47 of Article 7 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Carroll County," subtitle "County Treasurer and Clerk to the County Commissioners," increasing the compensation of the County Treasurer and Clerk to the County Commissioners, and providing for an Assistant Clerk to said County Commissioners.

SECTION 1. Beitenacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 47 of Article 7 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Carroll County," sub-title "County Treasurer and Clerk to the County Commissioners," be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:
