And be it further enacted, That the Commission may request from any Department, Board, Bureau, Commission or Agency of the State, such professional and expert advice, assistance and data as will enable it to properly carry out its activities and effectuate its purposes hereunder; and such State Department, Board, Bureau, Commission or Agency is authorized and directed to co-operate as far as may be practicable with the Commission in furtherance of its purposes
- Sec. 6. And be it further enacted, That the Commission is hereby authorized and empowered to make definite recommendations for the expenditure, use and allocation of funds deemed necessary to carry out its recommendations.
- Sec. 7. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1945.

CHAPTER 1037.

(House Bill 633)

AN ACT to add two new sections to Article 23 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Corporations," sub title "Public Service Commission," said new sections to be known as Sections 360A and 360B, and to follow immediately after Section 360 of said Article, to provide for regulation by the Public Service Commission and issuance of permits for motor vehicles used for transportation of passengers in charter and contract service.
