Code (1939 Edition—being Article 16 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "Montgomery County", subtitle "State's Attorney", Section 1089 having been amended by Chapter 250 of the Acts of 1941 and Section 1091 having been amended by Chapter 393 of the Acts of 1943, increasing the salaries of the State's Attorney and of the Law Assistant, and changing the title of the present Law Assistant to Assistant State's Attorney.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sections 1089 and 1091-1094, inclusive, of the Montgomery County Code (1939 Edition—being Article 16 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "Montgomery County", sub-title "State's Attorney", Section 1089 having been amended by Chapter 250 of the Acts of 1941 and Section 1091 having been amended by Chapter 393 of the Acts of 1943, be and they are hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

1089. The State's Attorney for Montgomery County shall receive an annual salary of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) for the performance of the official duties of his said office, which now or hereafter may be required by law, said salary to be in lieu of all fees, appearance and trial, and all other compensation for same, and to be payable monthly by the County Treasurer, upon an order of the County Commissioners, the said duties shall also include his services before the Justice of the Peace or Trial Magistrates of said County in criminal cases in preliminary hearings or trials when in the public interest he attends on his own motion or at the request of any of the said justices or Trial Magistrates, and shall include all advice regarding criminal law and procedure which he shall give any Justice of the Peace or Trial Magis trate of said county; provided, however, that his actual expenses incurred in following and trying criminal cases removed from said county shall be paid in addition to his salary; and that all general or local laws inconsistent with the provisions of this sub-title of this Article be and the same are hereby repealed.

1091. The State's Attorney for Montgomery County is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to appoint a Assistant State's Attorney to said State's Attorney at a compensation of the sum of Thirty-six Hundred Dollars (\$3,600.00) per annum, to be paid by the County Commissioners of said County, said salary to be paid monthly. The said Assistant State's Attorney, who shall be a member of the Bar of the Court of Appeals of Maryland, shall perform such work in said State's Attorney's office and such other work as he may be
