CHAPTER 26.

(Senate Bill 4)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sub-section (b) of Section 228 of Article 81 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1943 Supplement), title "Revenue and Taxes", sub-title "Income Tax", defining the term "dependent" in connection with personal exemptions allowed under the State Income Tax Law.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sub-section (b) of Section 228 of Article 81 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1943 Supplement), title "Revenue and Taxes", sub-title "Income Tax", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

- 228. (b) Four hundred dollars (\$400) for each person (other than husband or wife) who is a dependent as herein defined. The term "dependent" means any of the following persons who have a gross income under \$500.00 per year, and over half of whose support, for the calendar year in which the taxable year of the taxpayer begins, was received from the taxpayer:
- (A) a son or daughter of the taxpayer, or a descendant of either,

(B) a stepson or stepdaughter of the taxpayer,

(C) a brother, sister, stepbrother, or stepsister of the tax-payer,

(D) the father or mother of the taxpayer, or an ancestor of either,

(E) a stepfather or stepmother of the taxpayer,

(F) a son or daughter of a brother or sister of the taxpayer,
(G) a brother or sister of the father or mother of the tax-

(H) a son-in-law, daughter-in-law, father-in-law, mother-

in-law, brother-in-law, or sister-in-law of the taxpaver.

As used in this sub-section the terms "brother" and "sister" include a brother or sister by the half-blood. For the purposes of determining whether any of the foregoing relationships exist, a legally adopted child of a person shall be considered a child of such person by blood. The term "dependent" does not include any individual who is a citizen or subject of a foreign country unless such individual is a resident of the United States or of a country contiguous to the United States.

Sec. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act is hereby declared to be an emergency law and necessary for the imme-
