WHEREAS, the provisions of these sections are no longer necessary; therefore

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Sections 419-421 of Article 8 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title “Cecil County,” sub-title “Roads,” be and they are hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1945.

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CHAPTER 262.

(Senate Bill 187)

AN ACT to repeal Sections 242-282 of Article 8 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title “Cecil County,” sub-title “Liquor and Intoxicating Drinks,” relating to the sale of alcoholic beverages.

WHEREAS, Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland has superseded the provisions of these sections; therefore

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Sections 242-282 of Article 8 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title “Cecil County,” sub-title “Liquor and Intoxicating Drinks,” be and they are hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1945.
