members shall be elected to the Board of County Commissioners for Allegany County, who shall serve for the period of four years, or until their successors are elected and qualified.

- SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That Section 92 of said Article 1 be and it is hereby repealed.
- SEC. 3. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1945.

CHAPTER 302.

(Senate Bill 131)

AN ACT to repeal Section 60 of Article 1 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Allegany County," sub-title "Circuit Court," said section relating to the index of judgment records of Allegany County from 1900 to 1915.

WHEREAS, the provisions of this section have already been complied with; therefore

SECTION 1. Beit enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 60 of Article 1 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Allegany County," sub-title "Circuit Court," be and it is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1945.
