

Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Sheriffs", sub-title "Deputy Sheriffs", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

51. The provisions of the foregoing sections in this sub-title shall only apply to Baltimore and Washington Counties, but the powers conferred by virtue hereof upon members of fire companies shall not apply or be exercised in incorporated cities, towns or villages which maintain an organized or regular police force.

Sec. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1st, 1945.

CHAPTER 376.

(House Bill 334)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 22 of Article 23 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Wicomico County", sub-title "County Commissioners", and to add a new section to said Article, said new section to be known as Section 22A and to follow immediately after Section 22 of said Article, conferring certain additional powers upon the County Commissioners of Wicomico County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 22 of Article 23 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Wicomico County", sub-title "County Commissioners", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, and that a new section be and it is hereby added to said Article, said new section to be known as Section 22A, to follow immediately after Section 22 of said Article, and all to read as follows:

22. At the next general election there shall be five county commissioners elected for Wicomico County. The Commissioners of Wicomico County shall have all the powers and perform such duties as are now or may hereafter be conferred by law upon the County Commissioners in the several counties in this State as well as all the powers now or hereafter conferred under the provisions of this Article and not inconsistent herewith.
