32. (Seventh). To deposit securities for the purpose of securing deposits of the United States Government and its agencies, and the State of Maryland and its departments and agencies, including the Treasurer and Comptroller, and counties, cities, towns and other political sub-divisions of the State of Maryland, or to secure the surety or sureties on bonds furnished to secure such deposits, and to pledge securities to secure the prompt repayment of deposits of money of estates administered under the Bankruptcy Laws of the United States.

58. (Eleventh). To deposit securities for the purpose of securing deposits of the United States Government and its agencies, and the State of Maryland and counties, cities, towns, and other political sub-divisions of the State of Maryland and its departments and agencies, including the Treasurer and Comptroller, or to secure the surety or sureties on bonds furnished to secure such deposits, and to pledge securities to secure the prompt repayment of deposits of money of estates administered under the Bankruptcy Laws of the United States.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1945.

## CHAPTER 387.

(Senate Bill 221)
