

curve a further distance of one hundred feet to another point where this end of Riverway terminates and runs into and again intersects with Southway. The entire roadway involved measures in all a total of seven hundred twenty-five feet in length, more or less, is approximately fifteen feet in width at its narrowest point, and, with the exception of said one hundred seventy-five foot branch off of the road, is circular in shape.

Being the roadbed described and shown on the plat of Pines-on-the-Severn prepared and used by the Engineering Department of the Sanitary Commission for Anne Arundel County.

(3) Beginning for the same at a point approximately one-half mile east of the Governor Ritchie Highway on the Cypress Creek Road and running thence in a southeasterly direction for a distance of approximately eighteen hundred feet, the point of ending being approximately 300 feet from the south fork of Cypress Creek.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1945.

CHAPTER 438.

(Senate Bill 506)

AN ACT to add a new Section to Article 16 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Chancery," sub-title "Non Compos Mentis," to follow immediately after Section 127 of said Article, to be known as Section 127-A of said Article, authorizing Courts which may have appointed a Guardian, Committee or Trustee of the property of a person non compos mentis to order a sale of property held by such person non compos mentis and his or her spouse, as tenants by the entireties.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That a new Section be and it is hereby added to Article 16 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Chancery," sub-title "Non Compos Mentis," to follow immediately after Section 127 of said Article, to be known as Section 127-A of said Article and to read as follows:

127-A When property is held as tenants by the entireties and either spouse shall be adjudicated a lunatic and
