said name and number of license issue to him. Said license shall only be valid during the open season provided by law for

the hunting of wild water fowl in this State.

The Clerks of the Circuit Court of Frederick, Montgomery, Washington, Harford, and Cecil Counties shall on the first day of July, 1943, and on the first day of each and every month thereafter transmit to the Comptroller of the State all moneys received by them for the issuance of the aforesaid licenses and said moneys so received by the Comptroller shall be placed to the credit of the State Game Protection Fund, and said Clerks shall report to the State Game Warden the first of each and every month the name and address of each licensee to whom they have issued license the preceding month for a skiff or rowboat, designating number of said license and description of said boat.

- Sec. 2. And be it further enacted, That all laws or parts of laws inconsistent with the provisions of this Act, be and they are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
- Sec. 3. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1945.
