

stock companies writing the same classes of business requiring the Commissioner, under the provisions of Sections 102 and 146 of this Article, to institute proceedings for the rehabilitation or liquidation of such stock companies referred to in said sections, then, in such case, any mutual company so in default shall issue no policy or contract for a cash premium without an additional contingent premium, until its surplus shall have been restored to the amount required by this Act to authorize the issuance by such company of non-assessable policies or contracts.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1945.

CHAPTER 586.

(House Bill 579)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 20 of Article 99 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1943 Supplement), title "Birds, Game and Inland Water Fish", sub-title "Hunter's License", providing penalty for hunting without a license.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 20 of Article 99 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1943 Supplement), title "Birds, Game and Inland Water Fish", sub-title "Hunter's License", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

20. (Hunter's License Required to Hunt Wild Water Fowl.) All persons hunting wild water fowl on any of the waters of this State must first procure a hunter's license to so hunt, shoot, or kill. Local licenses issued to residents of Harford and Cecil Counties shall be valid for the killing of water fowl on the Susquehanna Flats.

Penalty for violation of this section shall be the same as that provided in Section 19 of this Article, for hunting without license.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1945.
