SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1945.

CHAPTER 689.

(Senate Bill 565)

AN ACT to repeal Sections 3—5, inclusive, of Article 1 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title “Allegany County,” sub-title “Almshouse,” relating to binding out minors.

WHEREAS, the State apprenticeship laws have been repealed; therefore

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Sections 3—5, inclusive, of Article 1 of the Code of Public Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title “Allegany County,” sub-title “Almshouse,” be and they are hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1945.
