CHAPTER 756.

(Senate Bill 620)

AN ACT to re-number Sections 33-A to 33-O, inclusive, of Article 1A of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "City of Cumberland," sub-title "Police and Fire," as said sections were enacted by Chapter 436 of the Acts of 1943, to read Sections 36-A to 36-O, inclusive, and to follow immediately after Section 36 of said Article.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Sections 33-A to 33-O, inclusive, of Article 1A of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition, title "City of Cumberland," sub-title "Police and Fire," as said sections were enacted by Chapter 436 of the Acts of 1943, be and they are hereby re-numbered to read Sections 36-A to 36-O, inclusive, of said Article, and to follow immediately after Section 36 of said Article.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1945.

CHAPTER 757.

(Senate Bill 651)
