

years or more prior to June 1, 1927, and who, in the case of Frederick and Caroline Counties, shall have been a teacher for a period of twenty years (20) or more prior to June 1, 1927; and who, in the case of Washington County, shall have been a teacher, or a clerk, or both, whether at the same time or at different times, for a period of twenty-five years or more, prior to June 1, 1927, and who

(2) shall be ineligible for a pension under this sub-title; and who

(3) shall be at least sixty (60) years of age; and

(4) whose record as such teacher shall be without reproach; and who

(5) shall be unable to teach school because of physical disability or infirmity; and who

(6) shall be without other means of comfortable support, shall receive a pension of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) per annum, payable quarterly, from the County Commissioners of the county in which the teacher has taught. Provision for the payment of said pensions shall be made in the next annual tax levy and in all future tax levies of said Counties.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1945.

CHAPTER 790.

(Senate Bill 426)

AN ACT authorizing and directing the County Commissioners of Garrett County to levy a total of Two Hundred Twenty-one Thousand Dollars (\$221,000.) for the years 1946 to 1953, inclusive, for the purpose of erecting certain new school buildings and additions to school buildings in Garrett County and for the acquisition of any site or sites necessary therefor, and authorizing the County Commissioners or County Board of Education to borrow money, under certain conditions.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the County Commissioners of Garrett County be and they are hereby authorized and directed to levy a sum of money not less than Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.) nor more than Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000.) for each of the years 1946, 1947, 1948, 1949,
