All the streets, alleys, lanes and public grounds in the said town of Rock Hall shall be subject, however, at all times for municipal and police purposes, to the control of the corporation, who may establish, maintain, alter and repair said streets, alleys, lanes and public grounds, and to make such improvements thereof and thereon as may from time to time seem to be necessary, as herein provided.
