Sec. 3. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1949.

CHAPTER 519

(House Bill 122)

AN ACT to add a new section to Article 43 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Health", sub-title "Undertakers", said new section to be known as Section 345A and to follow immediately after Section 345 of said Article, as said section was amended by Chapter 741 of the Acts of 1945, relating to the licensing of Veterans as Funeral Directors and Embalmers under certain conditions.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That a new section be and it is hereby added to Article 43 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Health", sub-title "Undertakers", said new section to be known as Section 345A and to follow immediately after Section 345 of said Article, as said section was amended by Chapter 741 of the Acts of 1945, and to read as follows:

345A. Notwithstanding any provision of this sub-title to the contrary, any honorably discharged Veteran of World War II who is a graduate of a recognized college of Embalming and has held a license and has actually engaged in the practice of Funeral Directing and Embalming in another State for a period of five years, and who has practiced in the State of Maryland as a duly registered Apprentice Funeral Director and Embalmer for a period of one year, shall be entitled to be licensed to practice Funeral Directing and Embalming in Maryland without the necessity of taking an examination.

Sec. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1949.

CHAPTER 520

(House Bill 132)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 40 of Article 16 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947 Supplement), title "Chancery", sub-title "Divorce", relating to the grounds for which a divorce may be decreed.
