of Cumberland shall be entitled to a vacation of not less than fifteen days annually.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sub-section (a) of Section 36 (LL) of Article 1A of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "City of Cumberland", sub-title "Police and Fire", said sub-section having been enacted by Chapter 572 of the Acts of 1947, be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

36 (LL).

- (a) Members of the Classified Service of the City of Cumberland shall be entitled to a vacation of not less than fifteen days with pay annually after one year of service.
- Sec. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1949.

CHAPTER 532

(House Bill 255)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sub-section (1) of Section 21 of Article 99 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947 Supplement), title "Birds, Game and Inland Water Fish", sub-title "Upland and Migratory Game Birds and Game Animals", relating to molesting protected species of fur-bearing animals in their dens.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sub-section (1) of Section 21 of Article 99 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947 Supplement), title "Birds, Game and Inland Water Fish", sub-title "Upland and Migratory Game Birds and Game Animals", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

21.

(1) It shall be unlawful to smoke, burn or otherwise molest any game or protected species of fur-bearing animal in any den or to damage or destroy the den of any protected game species or protected species of fur-bearing animal. It shall be unlawful to injure, take or kill any game or protected species of fur-bearing animal which has taken refuge in any den.
