## CHAPTER 558

(House Bill 414)

AN ACT to add four new sections to the Anne Arundel County Code (1947 Edition), being Article 2 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "Anne Arundel County", sub-title "Fire Companies", said new sections to be known as Sections 332A-332D, inclusive, and to follow immediately after Section 332 of said Article, relating to the levy of a special fire tax in the second precinct of the Fifth Election District of Anne Arundel County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That four new sections be and they are hereby added to the Anne Arundel County Code (1947 Edition, being Article 2 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "Anne Arundel County", sub-title "Fire Companies", said new sections to be known as Sections 332A-332D, inclusive, and to follow immediately after Section 332 of said Article, and all to read as follows:

332A. (a) The provisions of this section shall apply to and be effective in the second precinct of the Fifth Election District of Anne Arundel County.

(b) The County Commissioners of Anne Arundel County are hereby authorized to levy for the year 1950 and annually thereafter a fire tax of ten cents on every One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) of the assessed value of all real and personal property located in the second precinct of the Fifth Election District.

(c) The said fire tax shall be levied and collected in the same manner as other State and County taxes are now levied and collected.

(d) The proceeds of said fire tax shall be paid by the County Commissioners semi-annually on June 30 and December 31 of
