this Act shall not go into effect or become operative in either Baltimore City or Baltimore County, or both, as the case may be.

SEC. 4. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1949.

CHAPTER 709

(House Bill 231)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 87F of Article 13 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (Higinbothom's 1942 Edition), title "Harford County", sub-title "Assessments", as enacted by Chapter 289 of the Acts of 1943, changing the compensation of county commissioners for reviewing assessments.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 87F of Article 13 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (Higinbothom's 1942 Edition), title "Harford County", sub-title "Assessments", as enacted by Chapter 289 of the Acts of 1943, be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

87F. When said Commissioners meet to review assessments as provided herein, each member thereof shall receive for such services the sum provided by law in addition to any other per diem or salary compensation for their office.

The Board of County Commissioners is hereby directed, authorized and empowered to include in each annual levy of taxes following March 31, 1943, such sums as may be necessary to pay the salary and authorized traveling expenses of the members of said Board of Assessment appointed as aforesaid; the per diem pay to the said Commissioners when reviewing assessments, and all expenses for forms and clerical assistance necesary and proper to carry out the purposes of this section.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1949.
