possession for mounting. All such wild birds, wild quadrupeds, or fish, or parts of wild birds, wild quadrupeds, or fish acquired illegally or being possessed illegally, found in the possession of any person practicing the art of taxidermy and fur tanning, shall be confiscated by the officer making the arrest and turned over to the Director who may dispose of same as he may deem advisable for the best interest of the State. Any person failing to file a report as required by this Section, or filing a false report, shall have his license revoked for such cause.

Sec. 4. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1949.

## CHAPTER 203

## (Senate Bill 63)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sections 21(a) and (g) and 22 of Article 99 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947 Supplement), title "Birds, Game and Inland Water Fish", sub-title "Upland and Migratory Game Birds and Animals", clarifying the provisions of said sections.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sections 21(a) and (g) and 22 of Article 99 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947 Supplement), title "Birds, Game and Inland Water Fish", sub-title "Upland and Migratory Game and Birds and Animals", be and they are hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

21.

(a) The open season for game birds and game animals shall be as follows, excepting as changed by regulations adopted and promulgated by the Game and Inland Fish Commission under authority conferred upon it by Section 5:

Kind of Game
Greater and Lesser
Yellowlegs......August 16 to September 30, inclusive
Railbirds......September 1 to October 31, inclusive
Wild Water Fowl.....November 1 to January 31, inclusive
Wilson Snipe or
Jacksnipe.....November 1 to January 31, inclusive
