CHAPTER 245

(Senate Bill 303)

AN ACT to add a new section to Article 56 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Licenses", sub-title "Dog Licenses in Counties", said new section to be know as Section 328A and to follow immediately after Section 328 of said Article, relating to the status of certain dogs as personal property.

SECTION 1. *Beit enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland.* That a new section be and it is hereby added to Article 56 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Licenses", sub-title "Dog Licenses in Counties", said new section to be known as Section 328A and to follow immediately after Section 328 of said Article, and to read as follows:

328A. All lawfully licensed dogs in the counties of this State, the ownership of which can be proved, shall be deemed personal property, said provision not to apply to Somerset County.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1949.
