CHAPTER 127.

An act for the benefit of William Fowler, senior, of Howard District, in Anne Arundel County. Passed Feb. 24,
1841.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the commissioners of Howard District be and they are hereby authorised and empowered, at their discretion, to levy on the assessable property of said Howard District, at their next levy, and annually thereafter, during the life of William Fowler, senior, and while he continues a resident of said District, the sum of twenty dollars for the use of William Fowler, senior, and pay the same to him or his order. CHAPTER 128.

An act to authorise and empower Thomas Perry, former Sheriff and Collector of Charles County, to complete his collections. Passed Feb. 25,
1841.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the time limited by law, in which Thomas Perry, late sheriff and collector of Charles county, should have completed his collections, be and the same is hereby extended to the first day of March, eighteen hundred and forty-two; and that the said Thomas Perry shall within said time, be allowed to complete his collections, as fully as if the same had been done within the time limited by law.
