CHAPTER 133.

Passed Feb. 23, 1841. *An act to authorise Perry G. Hobbs, late collector of Howard District, in Anne Arundel County, further time to complete his collections of County Taxes, in said District.*

Time extended SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Perry G. Hobbs, late collector of Howard district, in Anne Arundel county, be and he is hereby authorised and empowered to collect any taxes, or balance of taxes, now remaining due to and uncollected by him, in the district aforesaid, in the same manner as he could or might have done within the time limited by law.

In force 12 months SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall not continue in force longer than one year from the date of the passage thereof.

Deliver an account of the sum demanded SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That the said Perry G. Hobbs, before he proceeds to execute the person or property of any person, by the authority of this act, shall deliver or cause to be delivered to the person or persons chargeable with the same, and at least thirty days before he shall proceed to execute as aforesaid, a particular account of the sum demanded of him, her or them, with an affidavit there-to annexed, that he hath not, nor hath any person, acting under him whilst collector as aforesaid, or since then, received any part thereof, or satisfaction for the same, to the best of his knowledge and belief.
