And be it enacted, That all vessels which shall Remove when be found obstructing the passage of said dock, shall re- requested move when requested by the master or agent of the passing vessel, in such manner as shall give a free and unobstructed passage to the said passing vessel, under a penalty In case of neof five dollars per hour, for each and every hour they shall glect obstruct the passage of such passing vessel, after due notice shall have been given to the master, owner or whoever may be in charge of said obstructing vessel.

And be it enacted, That the said penalties may Recovery of be recovered as other small debts, before a single justice of the peace of the city of Baltimore, from the master, owner or person in charge of said obstructing vessel, for the use of the master, owner or person in charge of the passing vessel, and obstructed as aforesaid; provided, that if the obstruction proceeds from any unavoidable cause, then the penalty hereby imposed shall not be incurred.
