CHAPTER 148.

Passed Feb. 26, An act to authorise the Consistory of the German Evangelical Reformed Congregation of Middletown, in Fre-1841. derick County, to purchase two acres of Land.

WHEREAS, it is represented to this legislature, that the burial ground belonging to the Consistory of the German Preamble Evangelical Reformed Congregation, is nearly filled up; and whereas, by the thirty-fourth article of the Bill of Rights, no sect, order or denomination is allowed to purchase or accept any gift, lease or devise of any quantity of land, exceeding two acres, without the leave of the legis-

lature—therefore,

May purchases Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, two acres land That the Consistory of the German Evangelical Reformed Congregation of Middletown, in Frederick county, be and they are hereby authorised to purchase two acres of land, in addition to what they now hold, to be used as a burial ground, and for no other purpose whatever.
