An act to authorise the drawing of a Lottery, to introduce Passed Feb. 27, a supply of wholesome Water in the Town of Port Tobacco, in Charles County.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Commissioners Maryland, That John Ferguson, John Barnes, Gustavus appointed Brown, John R. Ferguson, William B. Stone, Elijah W. Day, Francis R. Willis, Lynn Shackelford and William M. Hodges, of Charles county, be and they are hereby appointed commissioners, with full power and authority, by a scheme To raise by lotof lottery, and the sales thereof, or of the tickets therein, tery \$5000 to raise the sum of five thousand dollars, over and above all expenses and charges whatsoever; provided however, that Proviso the said lottery shall be drawn under the direction of the lottery commissioners, in pursuance of the act of eighteen hundred and thirty-five, chapter two hundred and five.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the scheme aforesaid scheme to be shall be approved by the commissioners of lotteries, or any one of them, before the same, or any tickets, shall be deemed to be authorised to be sold; and that before the Commissioners said commissioners may sell as aforesaid, they shall enter into bond, with sureties to be approved, and in a penalty to be fixed by said commissioners of lotteries, or any one of them, conditioned for the faithful performance of their duty as commissioners, and for the due application, for the purposes of this act, of all monies coming into their hands; which bond shall be made to the State of Maryland, and be filed in the clerk's office of Charles county court, and May sue bond may, on a certified copy thereof as evidence, be sued as other public bonds may, by any person or persons, or body politic interested in the condition thereof.
