SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That John Woolford and Susan his wife, and James Woolford, Josiah Woolford, Harriet Woolford and Susan Emily Woolford, his children, of Dorchester county, shall hereafter be known and called by the name of John Keene, Susan Keene, James Keene, Josiah Keene, Harriet Keene and Susan Emily Keene. Names changed

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That all contracts entered into, or acts done by the said John Keene, Susan Keene, James Keene, Josiah Keene, Harriet Keene and Susan Emily Keene, as such, shall be valid and effectual in law, to all intents and purposes. Acts confirmed
