ciety shall think proper to approve.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That the present members of May hold prothe said society, and their successors, by their corporate name, shall be persons able and capable in law to purchase, take, have and enjoy, to them and their successors, any lands, tenements, rents, annuities, chattels, registered debt or other public securities within this State; and the same at pleasure to alien, sell, transfer or lease, in such manner as they may judge most conducive to the charitable uses of said society; provided nevertheless, that the said corpora-Limit \$20,000 tion or body politic, shall not any time hold or possess property, real, personal or mixed, exceeding in total value the sum of twenty thousand dollars.

SEC. 4. And be it enacted.
