If vacancy oc- Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Macurs in the Se-ryland, That, upon the resignation of a Senator during the nate during re-recess of the Senate, communicated, in writing, to the Goto order election vernor, or upon the death of any Senator during the recess, it shall be the duty of the Governor to issue a warrant of election, to supply vacancies thus created, in the same manner as the President of the Senate for the time being is authorised to do in virtue of an act to amend the constitution and form of government of the State of Maryland, chapter one hundred and ninety-seven, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-six, and confirmed December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-seven.

And be it enacted, That, in all cases of resignashall tion or death, as aforesaid, the elections to supply the vacancies shall take place at the time and places of the annual election of delegates, unless such resignation or death shall occur between the first day of September and the meeting of the General Assembly in any year; in which event elections shall be held at such time as shall be directed by the Governor, with such notice as is provided by the act of Assembly for the amendments of the constitution and form of government, as aforesaid.
