SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of appoint 2 com- Maryland, That from and after the passage of this act, it shall be the duty of the Governor of this State annually to nominate, and by and with the advice and consent of the Senate, to appoint and commission two discreet and good men, as commissioners of lotteries, each of whom shall be entitled to receive an annual salary of twelve hundred and

fifty dollars, payable quarter yearly out of the moneys to be received by them as lottery commissioners of this State;
