A supplement to an act to improve and keep in order the Passed April 1, Streets in, and Roads near the Town of Saint Michael's, in Talbot County, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and seventeen, chapter one hundred and seven-

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Commissioners Maryland, That from and after the passage of this act, to keep roads in all that portion or portions of the road or roads, without limits of the town of Saint Michael's, and heretofore kept in repair at the expense of the authorities of the said town, as provided for in the act to which this is a supplement, shall be deemed and taken as a public county road; and shall henceforth be under the supervision and direction of the commissioners of Talbot county, and shall be kept in good order and repair, as other county roads are, under the provisions of an act, entitled an act relating to the public roads in Talbot county, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and thirty four, chapter three hundred and four.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That all acts or parts of Repeal of inacts, inconsistent with this act, be and they are hereby reconsistent acts pealed.
