Be it enacted by the General Assembly of vote by proxy Maryland, That at any special meeting of stockholders that may be called and be held for the consideration of the baid vall said act to which this is a supplement, any of the stockholders who may not attend in person, shall be entitled to be represented and to vote by proxy upon the question of the adoption or rejection of said act; provided, that a majority of the whole number of shares of stock shall be present, either by stockholders in person, or stockholders represented by proxy.
