

marble, granite, soapstone, limestone and lime, shall remain as authorised by the charter of incorporation. **CHAP. 89.**

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the right is hereby expressly reserved to the State of Maryland to repeal or alter this law at its pleasure. **Right to repeal**

CHAPTER 87.

An act to divorce Susanna Frank, of the City of Baltimore, from her husband Gustavus Frank. **Passed Feb. 19, 1841.**

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Susanna Frank, of the city of Baltimore, be and she is hereby divorced from her husband Gustavus Frank, a *vinculo matrimonii.* **Divorced**

CHAPTER 88.

An act to divorce Margaret Griffith, of the City of Baltimore, from her husband James Griffith. **Passed Feb. 19, 1841.**

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Margaret Griffith, of the city of Baltimore, be and she is hereby divorced from her husband James Griffith, a *vinculo matrimonii.* **Divorced**

CHAPTER 89.

An act to authorise the County Commissioners of St. Mary's County to repair the County Jail. **Passed Feb. 18, 1841.**

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the commissioners for St. Mary's county are hereby authorised and directed to levy upon the assessable property of said county such sum of money as they may deem necessary, to repair the public jail in said county; and said commissioners are hereby further authorised and directed to adopt such mode to accomplish that object as they may deem most expedient. **Levy directed**
