CHAP. 102.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That the said Harriet Lydia Stover, shall have and be entitled to the exclusive control, custody and guardianship of her children, born during her marriage with the said Solomon, without let or hindrance of her said husband.

Have control of her children

SEC. 6. *And be it enacted*, That the said Solomon Stover, shall not be liable for any debts to be hereafter contracted by the said Harriet.

He shall not hereafter be liable for her debts

CHAPTER 102.

*A supplement to an act, entitled an act to amend the Constitution and Form of Government, so far as relates to the division of Allegany County into Election Districts, and to establish an additional Election District.*

Passed Jan. 16, 1841.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the act passed at December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-nine, chapter one, entitled a supplement to an act, entitled an act to amend the constitution and form of government, so far as relates to the division of Allegany county into election districts, and establish an additional election district, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Repealed so far as relates to Allegany county

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the proceedings had, and the division made between districts numbers one and ten, in said county, under the Act of Assembly, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-seven, chapter one hundred and eighty-three, entitled an act to revise and alter the divisional lines between election districts number one and number ten, in Allegany county, and to change the place of holding elections, be and the same is hereby revived and declared to be in full force and virtue in law.
