CHAPTER 130.

An act to provide for the payment of the County Tax in Passed Feb. Anne Arundel County and Howard District of Anne Arundel County.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Collectors to Maryland, That hereafter it shall be the duty of the collecterly paytors of county tax in Anne Arundel county and Howard ments District of said county, to account for and pay quarterly to the respective commissioners of the county and district aforesaid, on or before the first Tuesday in June, September, December and February in each year, all money which they may have collected, up to the said periods.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That if any collector afore- violating the said shall hereafter fail to account for, and pay to the com- first section missioners aforesaid, the full amount of money collected by him as aforesaid, within one month after the periods specified for payment as aforesaid, he shall not be entitled to receive any commission on any balance of money thereafter to be paid by him to said commissioners.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That the same remedy shall and may be had against any collector or collectors as afore-tors said, who shall fail to comply with the provisions of the first section of this act within three months after the periods specified for payment as aforesaid, that now is and can be had against the collectors in Anne Arundel county.
