## CHAPTER 138,

An act relative to the School Fund of Washington County. Passed Feb 26, 1842.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Annual state-Maryland, That the President of the school fund of Wash-school fund ington county, on the first Monday of September next, and to be made. annually thereafter, state the amount of the capital fund, and the amount annually expended of said fund in the several election districts of Washington county.

## CHAPTER 139.

An act entitled, an act to make valid Judgments therein Passed Feb mentioned.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That all judgments heretofore rendered by any justice of the peace, in any case in which the warrant of the justice made the same returnable, the justice issuing the same, or some other justice of the peace, without mentioning any other justice by name, be and the same are hereby declared to be good and valid judgments, in the same manner and to the same extent, that said judgments would have been good and valid, if the warrant upon which said judgments were rendered had been special warrants, returnable
