CHAPTER 152.

An act to incorporate the Barren Creek Wharf Company.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Franklin Brattan, George W. Bounds, incorporated. Levin Phillips, Rider Wilson, Joseph Windsor, Jesse Walter and others, their successors and assigns, be and they are hereby created and made a corporate and body politic, by the name and title of the Barren Creek Wharf Company, and by that name and title, shall have succession, and shall be capable in law, to sue and be sued, in any court of law or equity, to have and use a common seal, and to alter the same when deemed expedient, and generally to do all such acts as shall be proper and necessary, for the purpose of building or constructing a wharf, in or near the mouth or junction of Barren Creek, with Nanticoke River, in Somerset county; provided, the said wharf shall not in anywise obstruct the navigation of the said creek or river.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That it shall be lawful for Capital not said company hereby created to enlarge the capital of said to exceed five company, when necessary for the purpose of increasing lars.
