

CHAPTER 159.

CHAP. 162

An act to divorce Mary Schaper, of Baltimore City, from her husband Henry Schaper. Passed March 1, 1842.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Divorced
That Mary Schaper, be and she is hereby divorced from her husband Henry Schaper, a vinculo matrimonii.

CHAPTER 160.

An act to divorce Anne Fleming, of Worcester County, from her husband Henry Fleming. Passed March 1, 1842.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Divorced
That Anne Fleming of Worcester county, be and she is hereby divorced from her husband Henry Fleming, a vinculo matrimonii.

CHAPTER 161.

An act regulating Executions against Life Estates in Lands or Tenements. Passed March 1, 1842.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Not liable to execution
That no real estate hereafter acquired by marriage, shall be liable to execution during the life of the wife, for debts due from the husband.

CHAPTER 162.

An act to extend the right of Challenge in certain cases. Passed Feb 28, 1842.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Right of challenge extended
That from and after the passage of this act, the right of peremptory challenge shall be allowed to any person or persons hereafter to be tried in this State, on indictment for any crime or misdemeanor, the punishment whereof by law is confinement in the penitentiary.
